

In-Text Citations

- ❑ Start by looking at the ann. bib.
- ❑ The first thing you see on the citation

Example: (Smith 201)	✓ Usually the author's last name ✓ Print or PDF = add pg. number; <u>don't</u> use "pg." or "pp."
Example: (Smith and Johnson 201) or (Smith et. al. 201)	✓ Include all authors up to 3. More than 4 = et. al
Example: (Johnson)	✓ Electronic sources = last name only
Example: (CDC)	✓ Corporate author (an organization)
Example: ("The Myth of Lies...")	✓ No author? ▪ Article title... "first 3-4 words..."

NEVER USE

1. URL
2. Webpage name
3. Google
